Instructions for **Night Sky**

- 1) You will need **1 piece of A4 dark coloured card (black, brown or blue)**
- 2) Fold the piece of A4 card in half, then cut along the folded line
- 3) Now the A4 card should be in two pieces – **you only need one of the pieces.**
- 4) You will need **1 piece of light coloured paper or card**
- 5) Cut round this piece of card which has a verse on it **THEN** stick the
the verse in the centre of the **Black or dark coloured card**
- 6) Decorate the Black or dark coloured card with stars

Note: If you do not have coloured card then you could use White card or paper and make your own picture by using pens, pencils and don't forget to put some stars in the sky bit!!

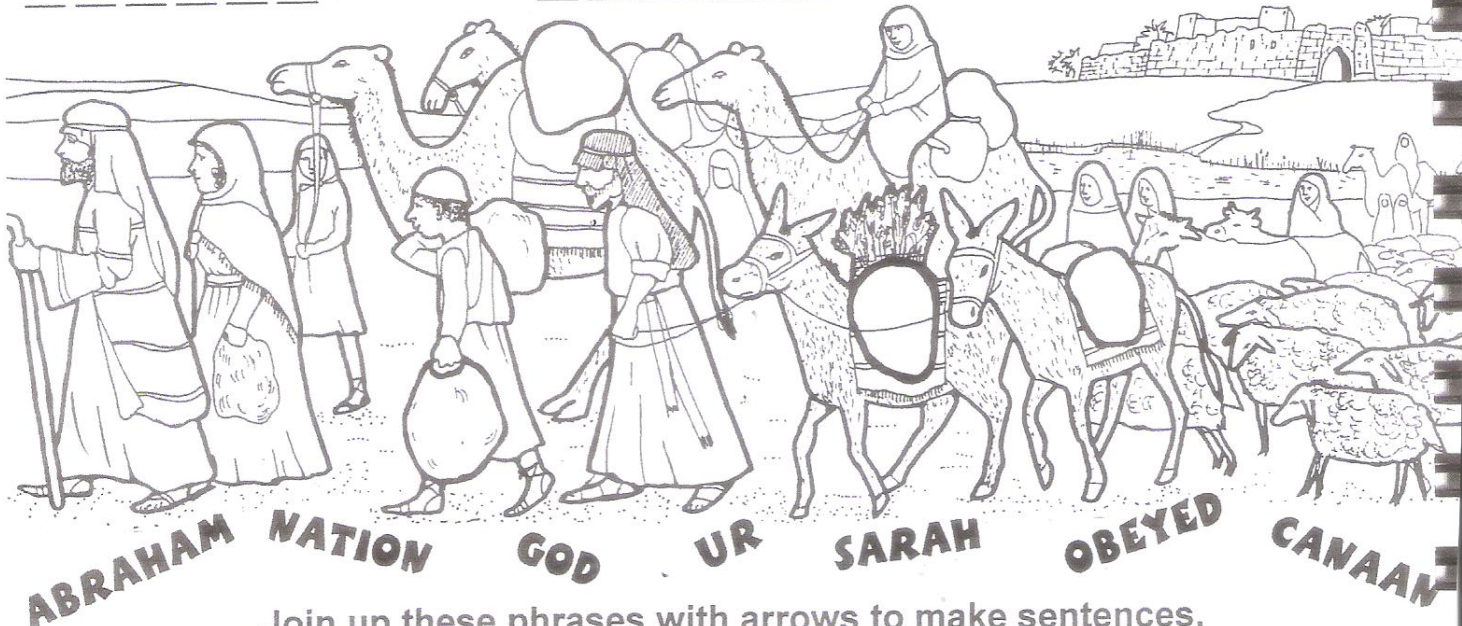
Cut round this verse then stick it in the centre of your Night Picture

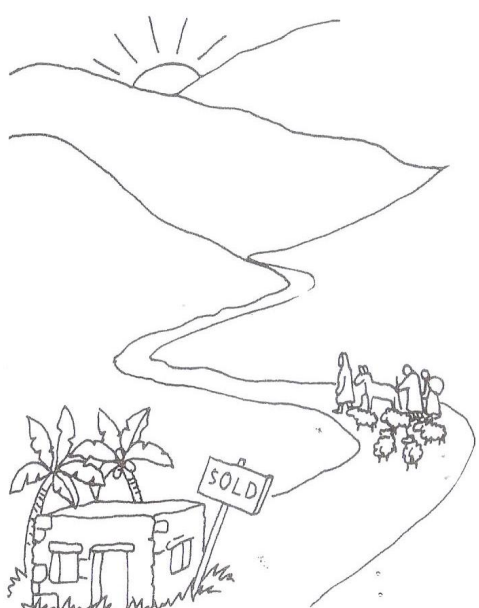

Join the dots to make a tent



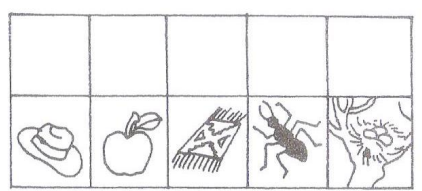
