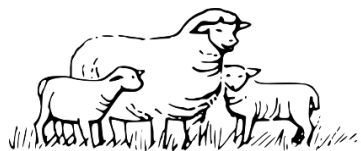

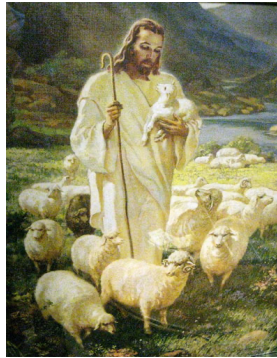
Saul became jealous of David even though David did many good things to help him. Saul tried to _____ him but God always kept David _____ because David was _____ to God.
